III. PROJECT JUSTIFICATION

1. Project Background:

The survey on illiterates reveals that one-third (1/3) of the total population of the municipality are illiterates. The result of the survey is alarming. These illiterates are poor, ignorant and unemployed.

Education component is considered as one of the basic services intervention that has to be provided in the pursuit of rural development. It is considered as continuous process of liberating the poor and ignorant from the bondage of illiteracy either in a formal manner.

Therefore, basing on these precepts, our government of today through the Department of Education has launched the Literacy Cum Livelihood Program with the hope that the illiterates and unemployed which constitutes the one-third (1/3) of our skills needed by them to become productive and effective members of our society.

2. Project Linkages:

Project similar to this have been undertaken and completed in some barangays of the municipality of Calape, Bohol. The beneficiaries of these projects have successfully acquired skills that provide them weaving skills, thus enable them to become productive members of the society they are living and made them responsible citizens.

3. Project Objectives:

- > To develop skills need for home industries for the working age population of Calape.
- > To increase the per capita income of the people in the municipality.

4. Sectoral Objectives:

- Ø To conduct demonstration and training on small scale industry sectors for quality control of its products such as the basket weaving.

5. Regional and National Objectives:

- Ø To support and promote the Kalakalan 20 program of the national government.

IV. PROJECT FINANCIANG

1. Funds Needed:

Two Hundred Eighty Thousand (280,000,00)

2. Project Financing:

This project with 25 clientele per batch will be conducted in barangays Abucayan Norte, Mandaug, Liboron, and Mantatao Island, Municipality of Calape. The Schedule of classes will be every Saturday and Sunday each week or every afternoon of week days until the 120 hours shall be completed as required. Classes will held in each barangay hall.

3. Funding Source:

National government and or TESDA/DTI and or any funding institutions.

4. Counterpart Funding:

The LGU concerned and the recipient barangays provide in the amount of 10% in cash counterpart funds and other nature of non-cash counterpart

5. Financial Viability:

Generate employment and income capability & the beneficiaries in contribution to gender development as a social impact of the projects.

V. PROJECT BENEFITS and COSTS

1. Beneficiaries:

Barangays of Abucayan Norte, Mandaug, Liboron and Mantatao island are the first batch recipient of the projects with at least 25 clientele of each barangay to be trained in basket weaving home industry.

2. Social Benefits:

The projects describe on the effects of value-incalcation, self enhancement, gender sensitivity/development and employment, opportunities. It will help them overcome inferiority and at the end encouraged them to participate actively in barangay activities.

3. Economic Benefits

- 3.1 The clientele will acquire skills in weaving baskets and other native products.
- 3.2 It would improve their socio-economic status.
- 3.3 Learners will earn additional income for the family.
- 3.4 Increase in volume of production and quality control of products for export purposes.

VI. PROJECT IMPLEMENTATION

1. Responsible Agencies :

The proponent of the projects is the families of the barangays concerned. The LGU through the Office of the MSWDO and MAO shall be responsible in the implementation of the project in coordination with TESDA and the District ALS Coordinator incharge in carrying out the programs.
