III. PROJECT JUSTIFICATION

1. PROJECT BACKGROUND

Farming is the main source of livelihood of the people. Low production is suffered by almost all farming communities in the LGU. Income from the farm does not go far when sold to purchase necessities. Composting as an alternative/supplemental source of livelihood be introduced as these farming families are living below poverty threshold based on the Poverty Reduction Survey conducted. Biodegradable wastes are composted in the Central MRF. Compost materials will be sold to other farmers as soil enhancers to increase production.

2. PROJECT LINKAGES

In the implementation of R.A. 9003, known as the Solid Waste Management Act of 2000, composting of biodegradable is mandatory. Composting is monitored by the DENR and the DA. The use of compost materials and organic fertilizers is introduced by the DA to increase production.

3. PROJECT OBJECTIVES

To provide alternative livelihood to our farming families who are below poverty threshold.

4. SECTORAL OBJECTIVES

To provide additional income to farmers who are solely dependent on farm products for a living. The project belongs to agricultural development.

5. REGIONAL AND NATIONAL OBJECTIVES

Reduction of poverty is the government's thrust push by the different line agencies. The proposed project provides additional source of livelihood to our constituents thus alleviating poverty.

IV. PROJECT FINANCING

1. FUNDS NEEDED

One Hundred Fifty Thousand Pesos (P150,000.00)

2. FUNDING SOURCE

Foreign donor

3. COUNTERPART FUNDING

The LGU will counterpart 15% of the project cost.

Direct beneficiaries of the project are the farming families living near the Central Material Recovery Facility (CMRF) where composting activity is done.

2. BENEFITS

Benefits from the proposed project will be additional farmers income from sales of compost material, employment opportunity in composting activity and increased agricultural productions from the use of soil enhancers.
